CVQO

CVQO students from both Bohunt and TPS schools have raised over £500 for the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance, by taking part in a Tri Sports Event that was held at the Bohunt school gym on 8 May. The learners planned the event, which involved all 12 of them using 2 x treadmills, 2 x rowing machines and 2 x running machines, with the aim of trying to cover the distance between the two schools, as many times as possible. They covered an amazing 89 miles in the 2 hour event; a truly fantastic effort! The Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance have also visited the school to deliver a session aimed at raising both the profile and awareness of their role within the community. The learners then visited the Airbase in Thruxton to hand over the cheque and to have a guided tour, which included running a training simulation within their immersive training suite

The final was against Weydon - a team that we had previously beaten - but the girls were under no illusion that they were going to come out fighting! The second half was again, a close encounter, but with two fantastic goals from Jess, Bohunt came away victorious with a 2-0 win. As a result of this Jess was also awarded Woman of the Match by the sponsors. All students played fantastically on the day and worked as a unit to secure the win. Well done!



South East Hants Athletics Championships – Thursday 18 May

We took 52 students to the South East Hants Athletics Championships on Thursday 18 May at the Mountbatten Centre in Portsmouth.

Our athletes were donning their new athletics vests, making us stand out from the crowd at the start line. This was not needed however, as their performances did all of the talking! The students claimed **20 medal places** across the four teams; junior girls and boys and inter girls and boys, which was a fantastic achievement.



The championship is set up to increase the performance of schools' athletics as well as to find the strongest school team overall and select athletes to compete at the County Championships. Our inter girls came 4th overall, with the boys improving on that with 3rd place. But our junior girls and boys displayed some incredible athletic ability, thrashing their opponents by taking 1st place in both categories! Due to these successes, our total points score from all four teams stood at 258, topping Bedales School by 2 points, making Bohunt the **South East Hants Athletics Champions!** This has not been achieved overall for a long time and so is huge achievement! There were many performances that helped achieve this result, including the ones that didn't place on the podium, so well done to all of our athletes.

Incredibly, **five** of our school records were broken throughout the day across a range of events!
