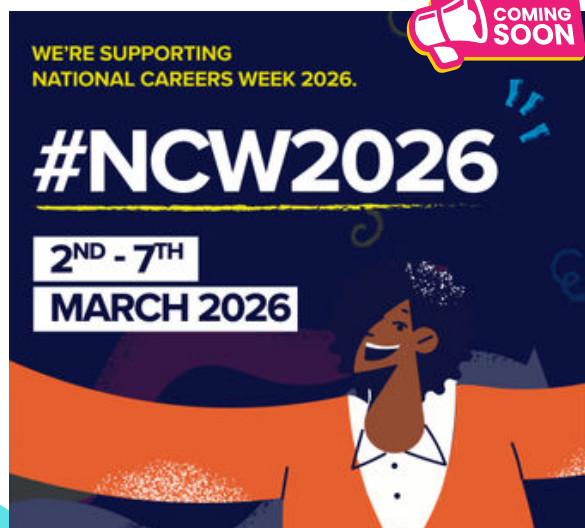
NATIONAL CAREERS WEEK! 2 - 7 MARCH 2026

The InvestIN Scholarship Scheme 2026

Applications are now open for InvestIN's Summer Scholarship Scheme 2026. This is an opportunity to gain a fully funded place on a one-week InvestIN Summer Experience in London.

InvestIN provides immersive career experiences for students aged 15-18, working with industry professionals in fields such as medicine, law, engineering and banking. You'll take part in real-world simulations, meet experts and visit leading industry locations across London.

To apply, you'll need to complete a written application explaining a bit about yourself and why you're interested. Shortlisted students will be invited to a virtual assessment centre, and successful applicants will secure a place on the Summer Experience of their choice.
