Olympiad success



Bohunt Sixth Form was delighted by some exceptional results in the 2026 UK Chemistry Olympiad 2026, marking the strongest performance in the school's history.

Organised by the Royal Society of Chemistry, the prestigious competition challenges the most able chemistry students across the UK with complex and demanding problems that go far beyond A Level study. This year, Bohunt Sixth Form students rose to that challenge with remarkable success.

An analysis of results against national performance highlights the outstanding achievement of Bohunt Sixth Form students:

- **Bronze and above:** 93.75% (National: 70.70%)
- **Silver and above:** 56.25% (National: 34.20%)
- **Gold and above:** 37.50% (National: 8.50%)

These figures place Bohunt Sixth Form significantly above the national average at every award level, underlining the strength of its chemistry provision and the dedication of its students.

Participation in the Olympiad reflects Bohunt Sixth Form's commitment to academic enrichment, providing students with opportunities to deepen their subject knowledge, develop problem-solving skills, and engage with chemistry at a higher level.

LAMDA success



Our students are celebrating an outstanding set of results in their most recent LAMDA (London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art) exams, with every candidate achieving a distinction. We are also delighted to see how LAMDA qualifications support students in developing confidence, communication skills, and their wider academic progress.

LAMDA exams are widely recognised for developing key life skills, including public speaking, critical thinking, and self-expression. Pupils take part in structured assessments building both performance ability and personal confidence along the way. Participation in LAMDA often translates into improved classroom engagement and a greater willingness to contribute ideas.

This year's 100% distinction rate reflects not only the dedication of the students but also the strength of Bohunt's LAMDA programme. Excellent coaching from our LAMDA teachers Miss Clarke and Mrs Harper, together with regular performance opportunities at Bohunt's LAMDA showcases have contributed to an environment in which pupils can thrive and achieve at a high level.

In addition to the personal development benefits, LAMDA qualifications can also contribute valuable UCAS points for students progressing to higher education. Exams at Grade 6 (Bronze Medal), Grade 7 (Silver Medal), and Grade 8 (Gold Medal) carry UCAS tariff points.

The letters for applications will be emailed mid-June so if you are interested in signing your student up for LAMDA tuition please do look out for it.
